# SING UNTO THE LORD

SATURDAY, FEB. 4TH 2012

A CONGREGATIONAL HYMN-SINGING WORKSHOP  
WITH SPECIAL GUEST DR. PAUL JONES

Can you imagine a worship service without singing? In the Scriptures we are invited, urged, commanded to sing praises unto our God. Psalm 147:1 states, “Praise the Lord for it is good to SING praises to our God; for it is pleasant and praise is becoming.” Yet we hardly ever spend any time considering why we sing what we sing, and learning to do it well! Come out and lift your voice in a concert of praise unto your God and learn how to give Him your best!

Session One | 9:00-9:45 a.m. | “What are hymns and why should we sing them?”  
*Dr. Jones will explain why the church has sung hymns for some 2,000 years. He will explain the origin of hymns, describe what genre of music/song they are, and consider why the church should continue to sing psalms and hymns in our day.*

Session Two | 10:00-10:45 a.m. | “What is “good” church music?”  
*Dr. Jones will set forth a number of criteria to use in determining whether a hymn is a “good” hymn or not. What should a “good” hymn include?*

Session Three | 11:00-Noon | “How can we sing psalms and hymns and sing them well?”  
*How can we sing better as congregations?*

About our Speaker | Dr. Paul S. Jones, *Organist and Music Director*

*Dr. Paul S. Jones has been Organist and Music Director at Tenth since 1998. He conducts the Tenth Church Choir and the Tenth Chamber Players and oversees the entire music program. He also serves as Adjunct Associate Professor of Choral Music and Director of the Concert Choir at Temple University’s Boyer College of Music, and is the founder and president of Paul Jones Music, Inc. Born in Moncton, New Brunswick, Canada, his earliest musical training began at the age of five in the Toronto conservatory program. Dr. Jones holds undergraduate degrees in music (performance and composition) and in Bible from Philadelphia Biblical University, where he served as a faculty member for eight years, the master’s degree in piano performance from Indiana University and the Doctor of Music degree from Indiana University in choral conducting.*
